Futures' Education programme continues to deliver projects across London complimenting and supporting the company's arts programme, most recently delivering programmes of drama workshops with young people exploring issues including bullying, sex and relationships.

Last year, Futures worked with the Healthy Schools team in Islington to conduct an extensive consultation with Year 9s in Islington around their experiences with alcohol and their opinions about alcohol education. As a result, a scheme of work for PSHE education addressing their needs and reflecting their experiences has been developed which will see Futures delivering over 70 workshops across the borough this coming summer.
